## Guinea Pig Feeding Guide



### Hay & Grass

- Unlimited (85–90% of their diet)
- Good quality high-fibre hay (Timothy / meadow)
- ✓ Grazed grass only – no clippings



### Fresh Veg

- 1 cup daily
- Variety of safe leafy greens and veggies
- ✗ Grazed grass only – no clippings



### Pellets

- 1 small cup daily
- Plain pellets fortified with Vitamin C
- ✗ No seeds, dried fruit, or nuts



### Fruit

- Treats only (1-2x per week in small pieces)

### Fresh Water

- Always available
- Use bottle with sipper



No chocolate, dairy, bread, avocado, or iceberg lettuce

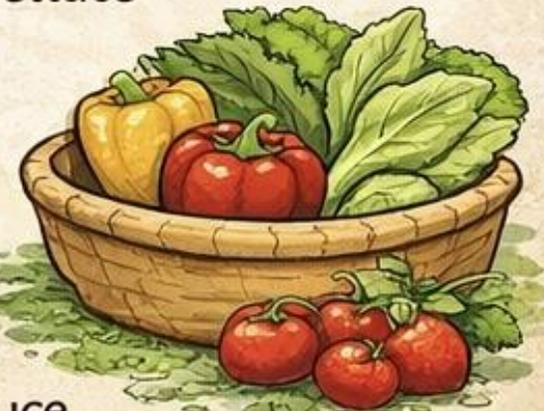
## Fresh Vegetables & Greens (About 1 Cup Daily per Guinea Pig)

Each guinea pig should receive approximately one cup of fresh salad per day, made up of a mix of leafy greens, vegetables, and herbs.



### Can Be Fed Daily

- ✓ Bell peppers (green, yellow, or orange)
- ✓ Butterhead lettuce
- ✓ Endive
- ✓ Escarole
- ✓ Green leaf lettuce
- ✓ Radicchio
- ✓ Red leaf lettuce
- ✓ Tomatoes (red, grape, or cherry)





## MISFITS RESCUE



Can Be Fed 2–4 Times Per Week

- ✓ Arugula
- ✓ Broccoli leaves
- ✓ Green or snap beans
- ✓ Red bell pepper
- ✓ Carrot (small amounts)
- ✓ Celery
- ✓ Chicory greens
- ✓ Cucumber
- ✓ Dandelion greens
- ✓ Garden cress
- ✓ Mustard greens
- ✓ Parsley
- ✓ Peas (in the pod)



## MISFITS RESCUE



Can Be Fed 1–2 Times Per Week

- ✓ Asparagus
- ✓ Basil
- ✓ Beets
- ✓ Broccoli
- ✓ Brussels sprouts
- ✓ Cauliflower
- ✓ Collard greens
- ✓ Dill
- ✓ Kale
- ✓ Raw pumpkin (no seeds)
- ✓ Spinach
- ✓ Turnip greens
- ✓ Watercress



No chocolate, dairy, bread, avocado, or iceberg lettuce

✓ Apple (skin on, seeds removed)

✓ Blackberries

✓ Blueberries



✓ Seedless grapes (red or green)

✓ Kiwi



✓ Mango

✓ Melon (cantaloupe or watermelon)

✓ Peach

✓ Pear

✓ Plum

✓ Raspberries

✓ Strawberries
